Meeting minutes – Minutes approved by acclimation.

QSL report - Club owes Nick \$0.80. One single QSL received in seven weeks, for the D-Day event, mailed from the UK on September 4<sup>th</sup>.

School club roundup – Tom, K3YH, mentioned that next week is the school club roundup and we would like to operate K3NEM from the museum station. Tom will put up a sign up sheet and he can be there Wednesday the 20<sup>th</sup> after hours if anyone wants to operate then.

Station status – Henry amp is now fully operational. Fred AI3Z cleaned RF deck and it seems to be working OK now. The left hand computer, however, does not seem to be syncing the logging file with the right hand computer. It appears to be a permissions issue.

Technician class report – Finished week 5. General class starts October 28<sup>th</sup>. 67 people logged on. We estimate that many people now use the recorded classes as well. People are very geographically dispersed. It was suggested that the club could provide some resources to locate both tests and clubs and other amateur radio information for the students who are now no longer geographically tied to the local area.
